

Spring Formal '10

Please read this information sheet carefully. You are responsible for understanding this information so that a fun night can be had by all. It is the goal of the Student Council, who is sponsoring this dance, for you to have a memorable time!

Date, Time and Place: March 20th, from 6:30 - 11:00 p.m. at the Waterfront Hotel Grand Ballroom.

Attendance: This event is open to grades 9-12 only. Each high school student may bring a date/friend (of the opposite sex) from another school (high school students only) if he/she wishes. *Dates/friends must abide by all the guidelines on this sheet as well. Please inform your guest of them.* A guest permission slip form must be completed and **returned four days** before the dance (permission forms are in the guidance office).

Schedule for the evening: The evening will start with a time of mingling, with dinner and dessert beginning at 7:00 p.m., catered by the Waterfront Hotel. After dinner, we will have the coronation of the King and Queen followed by dancing and socializing for the remainder of the evening. A professional photographer will be on hand to take pictures throughout the beginning of the evening.

Tickets: Only \$20.00 per person which includes a sit down dinner! You must purchase a ticket for your guest if you bring one. Tickets will be available for purchase at lunch times in the foyer beginning the 1st of March. You must be ready to provide the name, address and phone number of your guest *at the time* that you purchase a ticket for him/her. You must also know if your guest would prefer chicken, steak, or vegetarian for their dinner entrée. *(Tickets will be color coded for food choice, so you must choose when you purchase the ticket).* **Last date to buy tickets is the 16th.**

Attire/Dress Code: The dress code for this event is formal (traditional formal). That means formal dresses for the girls and *jackets and ties* for the guys (the type of tie is up to personal preference). No suits that call excessive attention to yourself. Dresses must be knee length (or longer) with no slits allowed above the knee. No undergarments should be showing - and dresses must be of the type that if you were wearing normal undergarments - they would not be showing. No backless (below where a normal bra would sit), strapless, spaghetti strap or low cut (no visible cleavage) dresses allowed. All dresses must have straps at least 1½ inches in width. Backs are not allowed any lower than the bottom of the shoulder blade. You are advised to alter the dress if it doesn't meet dress code. ***Please let modesty be your guide.*** This dance is a special privilege and we want everyone to come feeling elegant and attractive without the chaperones having to police what you are wearing. If you are not sure about the appropriateness of your dress, please ask before the dance. *If the dress code is not followed, you will not be permitted to attend the dance. Please inform your guests to avoid any embarrassment.*

Coronation - The court will be made up of the senior girls and their escorts as voted by the senior class. The High School Student Body will vote on the King and Queen on Wednesday, March 17th. Presentation of the court and the crowning of the King and Queen will take place after dinner.

Pictures: Isabell Photography will be taking professional pictures, with payment expected that evening for the purchase of a picture package, so you need to bring money (or a check made out to Isabell Photography). You may sign up for a package and a time to be photographed once you arrive at the dance.

Chaperones: This event will be heavily chaperoned. Guidelines for chaperones will be clear and discussed in advance. We desire to lift up the name of Christ in all we do, and it is the purpose of chaperones to be sure that nothing less than what is glorifying to God occurs.

Music/Dancing: Music will be provided by A&I and all music will be reviewed beforehand. If you have musical preferences, please turn those into Mrs. DeBoni ASAP. Be aware that all music must meet our Christian standard, i.e. - lyrics, message, words - and instrumentals of inappropriate songs are not allowed. (We all know the words!) Hug (both arms around neck) slow dancing will not be permitted, but waltzing - holding one hand is permitted. No provocative dancing will be allowed. Please come prepared to abide by these guidelines. *You and/or your guest will be asked to leave if you do not exemplify Christian behavior and respect for authority.*
