(We will pay by school check.) If you do not have your money in by May 27, you must purchase your tickets at the \$35.99 regular price!!!**

Middle and High School students and their guests will be chaperoned and will be required to follow school dress and behavior guidelines. 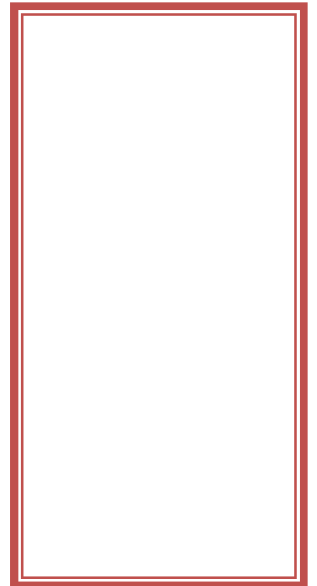
